

**ADDITIONAL PUBLIC NOTICE CONCERNING OAK CREEK WATER COMPANY,  
NO. 1'S APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF THE SALE OF ASSETS AND  
CANCELLATION OF THE CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY.  
(DOCKET NO. W-01392A-20-0096)**

On April 24, 2020, Oak Creek Water Company, No. 1 ("Oak Creek" or "Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for approval of the sale and transfer of its assets to the Oak Creek Domestic Water Improvement District ("District") and the cancellation of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N").

**The previously scheduled hearing date of August 18, 2020, has been vacated.** The Commission's Utilities Division will issue its Staff Report and associated recommendations to the Commission on or before July 20, 2020. The Commission's Hearing Division will then issue a Recommended Order for the Commission's final disposition. The Recommended Order is **tentatively scheduled** to be considered by the Commission at the **Open Meeting on August 5 and 6, 2020**.
